

## Polite Reminder

Our morning routine is pretty slick and parents and children are always very good but there are a couple of minor areas I wanted to mention. Please can we ask that parents do not go into school from the playground in the mornings without the permission of the headteacher. If you miss the teacher and have a message please either tell Mr Robson at the gate or pop round to the office. For safeguarding reasons we cannot have adults following the children into the cloakrooms or round the side of the building out of sight of staff. If Robins have already gone through their gate and up the ramp it is okay to take your child to the top of the ramp to help them in but not to enter the classroom please.

Can we also ask that those who regularly arrive after 8:50am aim to arrive 5 or 10 minutes earlier every day? We understand that traffic can be unpredictable and there are occasions when the morning routine isn't as smooth as we would like but it does tend to be the same people who are late. Most children don't like to be late and it can slow the beginning of the learning for the whole class as others wait for them to be ready. Thank you for your continued support.
