Many thanks to those who attended the Parents Forum Meeting on Monday. Items discussed were:

**Forest School** - Mr Robson confirmed that a letter has been sent out to parents regarding future use of Forest School. Unfortunately, with the time it has taken for the training for Mrs Denby and the imminent SATS, the Penguins will not use the facility in the near future, however, when the timetable is finalised there may be some activities that they can undertake along with the Owls and Swans after half term.

**Trip Money** - a suggestion was received that pupils should be able to take an unlimited amount of money on a trip to spend in gift shops etc. This may have arisen with the recent trip to Legoland, where we understand the gift shop is very expensive! It was decided that a limit should be adhered to but clear communication that money can be taken should take place and possibly some research as to what can be bought in advance for a reasonable sum may be useful.

**After School Activities** - the question was raised as to whether there would be any clubs that girls may be more attracted to (although we are aware that plenty of the girls enjoy golf and football!) A running club or dance club was suggested. Mr Robson will look into the options including new teachers who have volunteered to run clubs once they are settled in.
