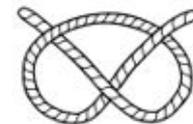

Staffing for September

The first bit of news to officially share and celebrate publicly with you is that Mrs Williams is expecting a baby. I'm sure you will join us in congratulating her and Mr Williams. She is due in November so will be with us until around October half term when she is likely to begin her maternity leave. As she will only be with us for a half term she will not have a class responsibility but will cover other classes for PPA or leadership time, carry out SEN interventions and support new staff members.

To cover Mrs Williams' maternity we have asked Mr Culff to stay with us and to start in September. He will come up to Owls with the current Year 2 group that he already knows well. Mr Culff has proved himself to be extremely hard working and enthusiastic and he has built up excellent relationships with the children.
