Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow.

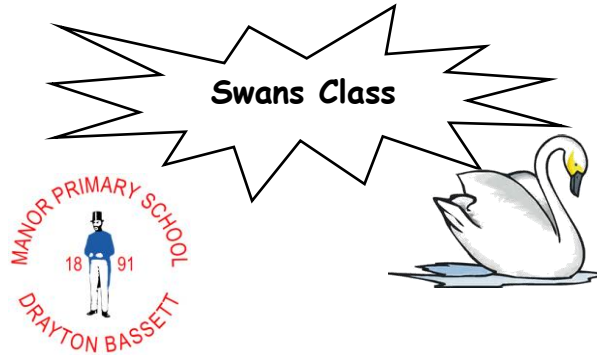
